This morning Derek Frank will be delivering the message:

“I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven”

Focusing on the passages of scripture found in Matthew 16:13-28

When Jesus came to the region of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets."

"But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?" Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Jesus replied, "Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by man, but by my Father in heaven. And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." Then he warned his disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Christ.

From that time on Jesus began to explain to his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things at the hands of the elders, chief priests and teachers of the law, and that he must be killed and on the third day be raised to life. Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. "Never, Lord!" he said. "This shall never happen to you!"

Jesus turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to me; you do not have in mind the things of God, but the things of men."

Global Aid Network (GAIN)



In the beginning of 2007, Campus Crusade for Christ, International asked Al Goff (an EBCG member) to start their first disaster assistance response team (DART). The DART assists Campus Crusade ministries in 191 countries to respond compassionately and holistically to wars and natural disasters. Through the response of love and help coordinated by Al and his team, the local ministry is able to advance the Kingdom of God through building Christ centered, Spirit-filled movements of multiplying disciples.

Since 2007, Al has coordinated disaster responses to the Iraq war, the earthquake in the Sichuan Province of China, the earthquake in Haiti, Cyclone Nargis in Myanmar and the Palestinian/Israel conflict in Gaza. The DART provides an analysis of what is needed and assists the local Campus Crusade and church ministries to provide a coordinated and compassionate response. The DART works with ministries to train their staff for disasters in advance so the response will be timely. Prior to 2007, Al led disaster responses for situations in Afghanistan, Indonesia and Bosnia, among others.

This DART works through the local indigenous staff as it implementing arm. This creates a bridge of love between local Campus Crusade staff, pastors and the local population. Then naturally and in accordance with 1 Peter 3:15, the local staff are able to share naturally when asked about why they are helping. The Disaster Assistance Relief Team supplies trauma counseling, relief supply distributions, and water and sanitation restoration through the experts working with Global Aid Network.
